The Orangeville Village Board met in the Village Hall on Monday, December 7, 2020. President Siedschlag called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. The roll was called. Members present: Mike Siedschlag, Joe Davis, Bill Guinther, Ray Parriott, Kurt Schilling, Tom Scudder, Mike Schindler and Toni Koester. Zero members absent.

**APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Schilling made the motion to approve the agenda with additions. Second by Scudder. A voice vote was called on the motion. *Motion to approve the December 7, 2020 regular meeting agenda with additions carried unanimously.*

**APPROVAL OF NOVEMBER 2, 2020 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES**

### **Tax Levy Ordinance**

Motion by Guinther to accept Ordinance 1207-2020 Tax Levy. Second by Davis. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Davis, Guinther, Parriott, Schilling and Scudder. Zero voted nay. *Motion to accept Ordinance 1207-2020 Tax Levy carried unanimously.*

### **Sanitary Sewer Issues**

Sewer lines on Church St need to have camera scope to determine issue with line. Possibly a collapsed line.

**\*\*Note for all residents – Do Not put grease in your drain. Causes problems in sewer lines. \*\***

### **Storm Sewer Project Approval**

Five bids presented for storm sewer project. O'Brian Construction - \$57,230. Senstrom Construction - \$57,640. Fischer - \$59,158. Helm Group - \$79,300. Intrack - \$114,500. Motion by Guinther to accept O'Brian Construction for storm sewer project with lowest bid of \$57,230. Second by Schilling. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Davis, Guinther, Parriott, Schilling and Scudder. Zero voted nay. *Motion to accept O'Brian Construction for storm sewer project with lowest bid of \$57,230 carried unanimously.*

### **Flow Meter – lagoon**

Flow meter needed for reports to EPA, currently electric line from over flow box behind building. Motion by Schilling to purchase a flow meter for \$7,411.50 from Vortex Technologies. Second by Scudder. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Davis, Guinther, Parriott, Schilling and Scudder. Zero voted nay. *Motion to purchase a flow meter for \$7,411.50 from Vertex Technologies carried unanimously.*

### **Spring Election**

Need to file petition for candidacy at County Clerk's office between December 14-21. Village President and three Trustees positions up for election.

### **CURE (Corona virus Urgent Remediation Emergency) Funding**

Village of Orangeville potential for \$32,714 (not guaranteed) from CURE funding. Use of funding for direct impact of COVID. Funding has been applied for. Can use for improvements to sewer/water. Want to change all door locks to keyless entry. Most will likely be reimbursed. Scata System upgrade of \$28,500 could be possibly reimbursed as well. Scudder made a motion to change all doors at Village buildings to Gokeyless for \$6,717.55 and Scata System upgrade for \$28,500. Second by Schilling. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Davis, Guinther, Parriott, Schilling and Scudder. Zero voted nay. *Motion to change all doors at Village buildings to Gokeyless for \$6,717.55 and Scata System upgrade for \$28,500 carried unanimously.*

### **Welder for Shop**

Littel presented need for a welder at the shop. Ex. - Could weld playground equipment in need of repair. Scudder motioned to purchase Eastwood amp welder for \$1299.99. Second by Parriott. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Davis, Guinther, Parriott, Schilling and Scudder. Zero voted nay. *Motion to purchase Eastwood amp welder for \$1299.99 carried unanimously.*

### **Water Billing**

More cross training needed for billing and meter reading within the Board for water billing.

### **Job Description**

Committee needed to head up wages/job duties for Village Board. Determine wage increases where needed.
