OPENING OF BIDS FOR 2016 MFT STREET MAINTENANCE

Willett Hofmann & Associates opened the bids for the 2016 Street Maintenance. One bid was received from Freeport Civil Constructors for \$35,809.00. The bid specifics were discussed including time-frame and street work around the school hours and bus schedule. A schedule and paper work will be provided at the Village regular August Board meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Fire Hydrant Use

Schmidt asked Siedschlag about the history of watering the football field with the water from the fire hydrant. Siedschlag had been in-touch with the school. Using the hydrant has been the process for at least five years. Before that it was the fire department. Rodebaugh mentioned she attended an Orangeville Athletic Association (OAA) July meeting. She had asked the group about the watering specifics with the hydrant. No update was provided to Rodebaugh other than the Athletic Director was in discussions with Siedschlag. Schmidt wanted the discussion to continue at the August regular board meeting.
