The Orangeville Village Board met in the Village Hall on September 6, 2016. Acting President Siedschlag called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll. Members present: Mike Siedschlag, Don Hoyle, Ray Parriott, Kurt Schilling, Leslie Schmidt, Mike Schindler, and Toni Koester. Members absent: Kayla Rodebaugh.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Schilling made the motion to approve the agenda with additions and corrections. Second by Hoyle. The Clerk called for a voice vote on the motion. *Motion to approve the September 6, 2016 regular meeting agenda with additions and corrections carried unanimously.*

APPROVAL OF AUGUST 1, 2016 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Schmidt made the motion to approve August 1, 2016 regular meeting minutes. Second by Schilling. The Clerk called for a voice vote on the motion. *Motion to approve the August 1, 2016 regular meeting minutes carried unanimously.*

Schilling made the motion to pay \$42,510.43 for August bills. Second by Parriott. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Hoyle, Parriott, Schilling, Schmidt and Siedschlag. Zero voted nay. *Motion to pay \$42,510.43 for August bills carried unanimously.*

OLD BUSINESS

Second Reading of Village No Parking Ordinance

Hoyle motioned to adopt the ordinance as read. Schmidt second the motion. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Hoyle, Parriott, Schilling, Schmidt and Siedschlag. Zero voted nay. *Motion to adopt the ordinance as read carried unanimously.*

Tree Removal Update

Resident Mike Wilson agreed to split cost of tree removal of tree between Wilson property and Village Hall. Chris Tree Service bid was \$1300. Hoyle made a motion to accept the lowest bid for tree removal. Schilling second the motion. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Hoyle, Parriott, Schilling, Schmidt and Siedschlag. Zero voted nay. *Motion to accept the lowest bid for tree removal carried unanimously.*

Bids for New Roof for Sewer Plant

Leverton bid: \$15,037.92, Zweifel bid: \$28,242.97, Just Right Construction: \$32,000

Motion by Schilling to accept Leverton bid of \$15,037.92 for sewer plant roof. Second by Hoyle. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Siedschlag, Hoyle, Parriott, Schilling and Schmidt. Zero voted nay. *Motion to accept Leverton bid of \$15,037.92 for sewer plant roof carried unanimously.*

Cintas Contract

Uniforms at weekly bid with 2 year contract.

Civil Additional work on Orange Street

Additional work to be done by Civil for culvert on Orange Street.

NEW BUSINESS

Fire Hydrant at High School

Use of fire hydrant at football field for watering field when needed. Intergovernmental agreement to be made by Dr. DeSchepper for use of hydrant.

Light Pole in Downtown Orangeville

Estimate of \$950-\$1000 from Precision Drive & Control for new pole for additional light downtown. Need estimate from Bordner for installation.

Wayfinding Signage for Village

IDOT provides Village signs but must have Jane Adams included on sign. Could include covered bridge. Can design own signs approximately \$250 per sign. Schmidt to follow up in November.

OTHER NEW BUSINESS

President's Report

Leverton had Dotzel line tested and problem from previous was not Village main.

Vandervalk residence visited about burning. Given notice that burn ordinance for Village and for County. Any future burning could be reported to authority.
