**APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Hoyle made the motion to approve the agenda with additions. Second by Rodebaugh. The Clerk called for a voice vote on the motion. *Motion to approve the February 6, 2017 regular meeting agenda with additions carried unanimously.*

**APPROVAL OF JANUARY 3, 2017 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES**
