The Orangeville Village Board met in the Village Hall on March 6, 2017. Acting President Siedschlag called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. The Clerk called the roll. Members present: Mike Siedschlag, Don Hoyle, Ray Parriott, Kayla Rodebaugh, Kurt Schilling, Leslie Schmidt, Mike Schindler and Toni Koester. Zero members absent.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Schmidt made the motion to approve the agenda with additions. Second by Schilling. The Clerk called for a voice vote on the motion. *Motion to approve the March 6, 2017 regular meeting agenda with additions carried unanimously.*

APPROVAL OF FEBRUARY 6, 2017 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Schmidt made the motion to approve February 6, 2017 regular meeting minutes. Second by Schilling. The Clerk called for a voice vote on the motion. *Motion to approve the February 6, 2017 regular meeting minutes carried unanimously.*

PUBLIC COMMENT AND COMMUNICATIONS

Resident, Marilyn Satness expressed her disapproval of her neighbor's tree that fell in her property. The neighbor, Devone, has since abandoned his property, leaving the tree in Satness yard.

Concerns expressed about large trucks parking at the South side corner of High Street and East Street, making visibility hard to see oncoming traffic when at intersection.

Rackow stated that the Starcom21 radio reception is poor. Stephenson County has mobile extenders/repeaters for the squad that have been offered as a trade with a Starcom radio. Second by Rodebaugh. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Hoyle, Parriott, Rodebaugh, Schilling, Schmidt and Siedschlag. Zero voted nay. *Motion to spend \$3,000 for the mobile upgrade to the website carried unanimously.*

Street Work for 2017

East Street and School Street to be repaired.

Mitigation Resolution

Motion by Hoyle to approve mitigation resolution with tornadoes added. Second by Schilling. The Clerk called for a voice vote on the motion. *Motion to approve mitigation resolution with tornadoes added carried unanimously.*

Water and Garbage Bills

Flushing of sewer plant needed.

Collection of water bills - need overdue payments caught up. Discussion of how to collect and keep all water bills paid up to date.

Business Development District

Sharon Pepin - no grants available to assist local businesses. Pepin mentioned increase of sales tax to generate money for business development district. Approach business owners on opinion of sales tax increase. Further discussion next meeting.

LESO

Application to be submitted to Department of Defense for LESO along with \$150 for consideration. Will take 3-6 weeks for decision. Once approved, can start to choose equipment desired/needed. Motion by Schilling to pay \$150 for Department of Defense application for LESO program. Second by Parriott. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Hoyle, Parriott, Rodebaugh, Schilling, Schmidt and Siedschlag. Zero voted nay. *Motion to pay \$150 for Department of Defense application for LESO program carried unanimously.*
