The Orangeville Village Board met in the Village Hall on May 1, 2017. Acting President Siedschlag called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Schilling made the motion to approve the agenda. Second by Parriott. The Clerk called for a voice vote on the motion. *Motion to approve the May 1, 2017 regular meeting agenda carried unanimously.*

APPOINTING VILLAGE PRESIDENT

Siedschlag stressed the need to find permanent Village President. Schilling motioned to have Michael Siedschlag remain Acting Village President for 2017-2018. Parriott second the motion. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Parriott, Rodebaugh, Schilling and Schmidt. Zero voted nay. *Motion to have Michael Siedschlag remain Acting Village President for 2017-2018 carried unanimously.*

OLD BUSINESS

Sidewalks Senior Citizens Apartment

Greg Williamson and Don Engelkens, representing Senior Citizens association, presented bid for sidewalk repair. Estimate of \$2,885 for repair to sidewalk. Requesting money from Village to help with cost of sidewalk repair. Motion by Schilling to split the cost of the sidewalk at a cost to the Village of \$1,442. Second by Parriott. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Parriott, Schilling, Schmidt and Seidshlag. Rodebaugh pending wording of resolution. Zero voted nay. *Motion to split the cost of the sidewalk at a cost to the Village of \$1,442 carried.*

Devone Property

Attorney Thrumman - options for abandoned property. Formally publish, legal ad of notice to Devone. There were 3 options of legal action. Motion by Schmidt to choose option 3, second alternative for public notice from Attorney Thrumman. Second by Schilling. The Clerk called for a voice vote on the motion. *Motion to choose option 3, second alternative for public notice from Attorney Thrumman carried unanimously.*

Mowing Contract

Motion by Parriott to have Chad Schmidt mow the easement for \$20 per mowing. Second by Rodebaugh. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Parriott, Rodebaugh, Schilling and Siedschlag. Zero voted nay. Schmidt abstained the vote. *Motion to have Chad Schmidt mow the easement for \$20 per mowing carried.*

Water and Garbage Bills

Need to devise a plan of how to collect outstanding water bills. Need a process in which to follow to collect on delinquent customers.

NEW BUSINESS

Electric Aggregation Contract

Resolution needed to accept Dynegy Energy for 2 year rate, starting November 2017. Residents still have option to choose supplier. Schmidt made the motion to approve the municipal aggregation bid agreement. Second by Rodebaugh. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Rodebaugh, Schilling, Schmidt and Siedschlag. Zero voted nay. Parriott abstained the vote. *Motion to approve the municipal aggregation bid agreement carried.*

Ordinance to be updated for liquor licensing by nonresident. Update fire burning, burning of garbage ordinance. "No" burning of garbage permitted.
