ORDINANCE No 9-7-10D

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING Secs. 6-11 and 6-12 of the Village of Orangeville Book of Municipal Codes

WHEREAS The Book of Codes does not address a place to file the yearly recurring appropriations and tax levy ordinances.

BE IT ORDAINED By the Trustees of the Village of Orangeville, Stephenson County, Illinois that Sec 6-11 is changed to:

Sec. 6-11. SPECIFIC - APPROPRIATIONS.

A. During the first quarter of each fiscal year, as required by statute, the President and Village Board shall enact an appropriation ordinance in which shall be itemized all anticipated expenditures to be met during the coming year, other than those payable from bond issues. This Code shall be published, as required by statute, within ten (10) days after its enactment.

B. A copy of the current Budget and Appropriation Ordinance is enclosed herein, at the beginning of Chapter 6.

AND that Sec 6-12 is changed to:

Sec. 6-12. SPECIFIC - TAX LEVY.

A. No sooner than ten days after the publication of the appropriation ordinance, a tax levy ordinance shall be enacted, as required by law, levying such taxes as may be needed to meet the anticipated expenses of the coming year, together with such taxes as may be required to meet outstanding bond issues, or for purposes payable from special taxes properly authorized. A certified copy of the tax levy ordinance shall be filed with the Stephenson County Clerk not later than the second Tuesday in December. Such ordinance shall show the total appropriated for each item, and the amount of tax levied therefore.

B. A copy of the current Tax Levy Ordinance is enclosed herein, at the beginning of Chapter 6.
