OLD BUSINESS

Devone Property

2nd Reading of Downtown Parking Ordinance

Reading of Chapter 12 Article VIII Parking, Section 12-51, change to downtown parking. Instructing all larger vehicles to park along North side of the 300 block of W High Street and the need for customer parking in front of doctors and dentist offices. Amended the ordinance to read that parking on Main Street from the corner of High Street to handicap parking shall be for cars only. There will be customer only parking from 8 am - 5 pm, Monday - Friday in front of the dentist and doctors offices.

Off Road Vehicle Ordinance

Amendment to Article XI, Section 12-81 to allow business, school and fire department to be exempt by approval of the Board of Trustees for use of off road vehicles.
