APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Schilling made the motion to approve the agenda with changes. Second by Guinther. The Clerk called for a voice vote on the motion. *Motion to approve the November 6, 2017 regular meeting agenda with changes carried unanimously.*

Downtown Parking on High St. and Main St. - Ordinance reading

Customer parking requested in front of dentist and doctors' offices. Parking on W. High St. is also a problem. Long trucks and vans extend into the road. Need for "No Parking for Trucks" along 300 block of High St. Should be cars only. Ordinance needed to have big vehicles parking on North side of street only. No trucks allowed on South side of street.

NEW BUSINESS

Off Road Vehicles

Dennis Crooks requested Village to review ordinance for UTV usage on public roads. He would like to be able to drive his UTV into town. The current Village ordinance states UTVs are prohibited unless use for Village clean up/emergency. Tabled for further determination of other Village ordinances, licensing, etc.

Sewer backup on South Church St.

October 13th - sewer backup at Erickson and Marcum/Hanson properties. Valleyview and Richland sewer lines drain to Church St. Items being flushed in sewer that should not be. Finding towels, paper towels, grease and feminine products. Waiting insurance claim to determine coverage or not.

Request for Class A Liquor License

Thomas' Cafe Three Eleven request for a Class A liquor license. Current ordinance states only three permitted. Motion by Hoyle to approve the fourth Class A liquor license in the Village of Orangeville. Second by Schilling. The Clerk called for a roll call vote on the motion. Members voting yea: Guinther, Hoyle, Parriott, Schilling, Schmidt and Siedschlag. Zero voted nay. *Motion to approve the fourth Class A liquor license in the Village of Orangeville carried unanimously.*

Priewe Busjahn Property

Interest by Arands to buy Priewe Busjahn property and build wedding/reception hall. Research needed to see if Busjahn property can be purchased or left as is per deed.
