

CHAPTER 3: VILLAGE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CODES  
ARTICLE I: GENERAL - Amended: 07/05/2017

Sec. 3-15. Retail - Persons Not Entitled To License.

No liquor retail license shall be issued to:

- A. A person who is not a citizen of the United States;
- B. A person who has been convicted of a felony under the laws of the State;
- C. A person whose license under this article has been revoked for cause;
- D. A person who, at the time of application for renewal of any license issued hereunder, would not be eligible for such license upon a first application;
- E. A co-partnership, unless all of the members of such co-partnership shall be qualified to obtain a license;
- F. A person whose place of business is conducted by a manager or agent unless the manager or agent possesses the same qualifications required of the license;
- G. A person who has been convicted of a violation of any Federal or State law concerning the manufacture, possession, or sale of alcoholic liquor, or who shall have forfeited his bond to appear in court to answer charges of any such violation;
- H. A person who does not own the premises for which a license is sought, or does not have a lease thereon for the full period for which the license is issued;
- I. Any law enforcing public official, the Village Liquor Control Commissioner, or any member of the Village Board; no such official shall be interested in any way, either directly or indirectly in the manufacture, sale or distribution of alcoholic liquor; except that a license may be granted, in a Village with a population of fifty-thousand (50,000) or less, to any member of a Village Board in relation to premises that are located within the territory subject to the jurisdiction of that official if (i) the sale of alcoholic liquor pursuant to the license is incidental to the selling of food, (ii) the issuance of the license is approved by the State Commission, (iii) the issuance of the license is in accordance with all applicable Village ordinances in effect where the premises are located, and (iv) the official granted a license does not vote on alcoholic liquor issues pending before the board or council to which the license holder is elected;
- J. A person who is not a beneficial owner of the business to be operated by the licensee;
- K. A person not eligible for a State retail liquor dealer's license;

L. A person who has been convicted of a gambling offense;

M. A person who does not have liquor liability insurance; and

N.. Any person or any store or other place of business where the majority of the customers are minors or where the main business is selling of school books, school supplies, food or drink to such minors.
