**AN ORDINANCE CHANGING** Chapter 16 of the Orangeville Book of Municipal Codes,

**WHEREAS** the Village has a new contract with Gill's Disposal that includes both a garbage tote and recycle tote for each household,

**WHEREAS** the totes have a barcode and will remain with the property they are coded for,

**WHEREAS** the resident is responsible for any lost totes and will be responsible for replacement cost for those totes,

**BE IT ORDAINED** By the Trustees of the Village of Orangeville, Stephenson County, Illinois that Sec 16-12 is changed to:

Sec 16-12 C&D – RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTION.

F. Each household has supplied refuse and recycle totes that are leased through Gills Disposal by the Village. Totes are barcoded to the address and all totes must remain at the property they are barcoded to. Replacement cost for any lost or damaged totes are the responsibility of the resident.
