

VILLAGE OF ORANGEVILLE  
ORDINANCE 0102-24

**AN ORDINANCE CHANGING** Section 3-39 of the Orangeville Book of Municipal Codes,

**WHEREAS** businesses within the Village have voiced a concern of their difficulties with finding people for employment that match the age criteria for bartending and retail checkout clerk, and

**WHEREAS** the Village has reviewed these concerns and have determined that it would be beneficial to business owners to lower the bartending and retail checkout clerks selling age from 21 to 20,

**BE IT ORDAINED** By the Trustees of the Village of Orangeville, Stephenson County, Illinois that Chapter 3, Article II: Retail License, Section 3-39 be changed to:

Sec. 3-39. RETAIL - EMPLOYMENT OF MINORS.

It shall be unlawful to employ any person under the age of twenty (20) years in any place in the Village to mix, handle or dispense alcoholic beverages. Employees must be twenty (20) years of age or older to act as a clerk to be authorized to sell alcoholic beverages at checkout counters for the sale of packaged goods or for goods to be consumed on the premises. Employees other than defined above may be eighteen (18) years of age in any place in the Village which serves alcoholic beverages. (Bartenders and retail checkout clerks must be twenty (20) years old or older to handle alcoholic beverages. Wait staff or other persons serving alcoholic beverages must be eighteen (18) years old or older. Bussers or other staff employed by the licensee other than bartenders, retail checkout clerks, or wait staff may be less than eighteen (18) years old.)
